The focus of this workshop will be on the emotional impact of technological innovation with special emphasis on its relation to artificial intelligence and all its emotional, social, collective, and psychological aspects including the coevolution of human habitat from an interdisciplinary perspective. It is very usual for the emotional burden to represent a bias even before understanding the inner workings of technology.

To gain a practical understanding of these challenges and the impact of artificial intelligence, there will be showcases by some entrepreneurs of Al technologies related to Goal 4 of the United Nations 2030 Agenda concerning Quality Education, aimed at implementing quality education, especially in parts of the world where schools are logistically underperforming. Other major companies will share the added value of their business and R&D experiences.

The most important audience for this workshop includes university students, entrepreneurs, investors, policymakers, policy modelers, nonprofit stakeholders, and citizen opinion leaders. The connection between business development, society, and neuroscience can be seen in the emotional impact they have on collective behavior, often at the crossroads between too much optimism and too much pessimism, the latter being much harder to manage without the support of neurosciences. What often accompanies innovation, as a matter of fact, is the feeling of fear of the future and the unknown, which hinders their diffusion.

This workshop will also serve to strengthen the multi-helix collaboration among institutional government, business, nonprofit sector, and universities with their strategic applied research.
